Outside my classroom I will have a peg to hang my coat and bag on. The toilets are beside the cloakroom.






There are lots of fun things to do in my classroom.

At the painting area I can paint on the easel with two other people.




The playdough station has rolling pins and spoons to play with. I can use cutters to make shapes with the playdough.

I can play on my I-pad or play with a friend on the computer.




I can also play with the dolls house and garage.
